His discography includes fan favorites like *Old Chevy*, *Gone Fishin'*, *Dixie Dreamin'*, *Millionaire in Mexico*, *Friend with a Beer*, *American Crazy*, *Beginning of Me*, *All You Gotta Do Is Dance* (which reached No. 7 on the UK charts and No. 80 on the Music Row charts), *I Know My Way Around This Town*, and *Redneckin'*. Most recently, he completed a new studio project with producer Eric Legg. His latest single, *Forever Don't Last That Long*, was co-written with acclaimed songwriter Danny Wells—best known for penning George Strait's classic, *Check Yes or No*.

Gavin Lee is quickly rising as one of indie country's top emerging artists. A proud member of both the Texas Music Association and the Nashville music scene, he's a familiar face at songwriter rounds in Music City and is steadily making his mark across Texas venues and festivals.
